EARN & LEARN SCHEME

The University provides specific amount of grant-in aid to meet the educational expenses of the eligible, needy and poor students under this scheme. The student prosecuting his regular studies of the UG course (excluding compulsory Internship training) of health sciences may apply under the said scheme. The grant-in-aid of Rs.2000/- per month is admissible to every eligible student for maximum period of eight months during every academic year. The Dean / Principal will allot College / hospital related work (two hrs. daily- excluding public holidays) to the eligible students.

5 students (3% reservation for physically challenged)

SANJIVANI VIDYARTHI SURAKSHA YOJANA

The University is providing financial aid to the regular students of the affiliated Colleges / recognized Institutes of the University during prosecution of his / her studies.

Ranging from Rs. 2000 to 2 lakhs depending upon the severity of the illness

Under this scheme, after receipt of complete proposal due to following incidence the financial aid of amount shown against each incidence is being admissible:

- i. In case of death (either due to accident / natural calamity / illness / natural) of regular student Rs. 2,00,000/- is admissible to the parents of the deceased student.
- ii. Permanent Disability of any two limbs, Rs. 2,00,000/- is admissible.
- iii. Permanent Disability of any one limb, Rs.1,00,000/- is admissible.
- iv. For surgery / treatment of major diseases (for e.g. surgery of brain, heart, lever, lungs, cancer, any organ transplantation), Actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs. 50,000/- whichever is less is admissible.
- v. For bone fracture or minor surgery, actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs. 10,000/- whichever is less is being admissible.
- vi. For dialysis, Rs.2000/- per dialysis is being admissible. (Maximum 04 dialysis per month).
- viii. If, hospitalized due to accident for more than 24 Hrs. then the actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs.2,000/- whichever is less is being admissible.

(All of the above to be reported to the university within 10 days)

3. Medicines/ investigations' bills.
4. In case of accident- FIR, Police Punchnama
5. In case of permanent disability- Disability certificate from the Civil Surgeon.

comparisons. Effective nursing care in the intensive care unit (ICU) plays a crucial role in stabilizing health parameters and improving patient outcomes. Methods: A quantitative research approach with an experimental and control group design was adopted. The study included 60 PTCA patients admitted to the ICU/CCU of selected hospitals in Pune city. Purposive sampling technique was used, and participants were selected based on predefined eligibility criteria. Tools included a clinical profile for assessing health parameters and a checklist to observe PTCA-related complications. The effect of the nursing intervention was analysed using paired t-test and Z-test. Results: In the experimental group on Day 1, 83.3% of patients had mild complications and 16.7% had moderate complications. In the control group on Day 1, 80% had mild complications, and 10% had moderate complications. On day3, Experimental group were having 33.3 % no complication and 66.7 % patient has mild complication. In control group 6.7% of them did not have complications and 93.3% of them had mild complications. Subsequent days showed a notable reduction in complications in the experimental group compared to the control group, indicating a positive impact of structured nursing interventions. Conclusion: The study concludes that structured nursing interventions significantly improve health parameters and reduce complications among patients undergoing PTCA. The findings highlight the importance of evidence-based nursing care in enhancing recovery and minimizing risks following PTCA.

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
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
